Activities Team Role Description

As and Adult, Explorer Scout, Rangers or Young Leaders you will support the Activities Team to aid the smooth running of some activity bases at Scram 2026. This may include assisting in running bases which may be understaffed, so you need to be flexible and adaptable as it could involve circulating among a number of tasks within the Activity remit: e.g. 2hrs on a Science base, 2hrs with human table football etc. We aim to avoid repetitiveness and provide a varied schedule for team members, whilst keeping each base fresh and efficient and contributing to the success of SCRAM.

Training will be given as appropriate and new skills may be learned. It is estimated that approximately 20 people (adults, Explorer Scouts / Rangers and Young Leaders) will be required.

Team members must be linked to the Scout or Guide movement and, if over 18 years of age, hold a valid DBS with either organisation.
