Site Team Role Description

The Site Team's core purpose is to respond to emergency situations and to ensure all site facilities are kept working and maintained in a safe, hygienic working condition.

Team members must be linked to the Scout or Guide movement and, if over 18 years of age, hold a valid DBS with either organisation.

Generic Requirements

- Be able to work as a part of a team with a team leader
- Be able to take initiative

Role Specific Requirements

Duties

Working in small teams maintain all the site services and facilities remain working during the event. Provide rubbish clearance services. Carry out hygiene/servicing of all the washing and toilet facilities. Maintain site infrastructure. Generally providing support and help to SCRAM participants.

Site Team are also responsible for the overall site which includes site layout, supervision of car and coach parking as well as the main entrance into the site, checking that everyone entering the site is wearing a wristband.

Key Skills

Willingness to Work, Adaptable, Sense of Humour, Practical Person.
