Parascending at Scoutabout 2022 is not included with your fees that you paid to attend Scoutabout. If you want to try this activity, it will cost £18 per person which includes all relevant training by the instructors, insurance and one flight.

Parascending is very much a weather dependent activity and if we are unable to give you your flight for this reason, we will refund your money.

All members of the Scout Association over the age of 10½ and Guide Association over the age of 14 (including leaders!) may take part in parascending and all must have a weight greater than 45kg/7 stone.

We have scales on site.

In addition, all participants **MUST** have their arms and legs covered and be wearing ankle support boots on the day of the flight.

To try a parascending flight on a round parachute whilst at Scoutabout, you will have to complete and send in the booking form (below) with a Personal Consent form (below) and a cheque for required amount.
